Organizations, and government aid too. <u>Jerry's Artarama</u>, a well know Art Supply Store (both with physical locations and an online shop) has stepped up to the plate, and is trying to help artists impacted get back on their feet by helping to replace some of the supplies, studio furniture, etc. they lost as a direct result from the storm. Thankfully there's a large number of <u>Emergency Resources</u> for Artists impacted by Hurricane / Tropical Storm Harvey.
